




Over-the-month employment changes, in thousands, Sep 2021 – Sep 2022





### Total nonfarm employment recovery


#### Total nonfarm employment, seasonally adjusted





### Major industry sector job recovery



















### Hires and total separations levels 2012-2022



### **Quits levels 2012–2022**



## Job openings levels 2012–2022










Total Monthly Anchorage Employment, 2019 Through Part Of 2022-Recovering




